BNY Mellon Stock Index Fund, Inc.

GOAL/APPROACH

The fund seeks to match the performance of the Standard & Poor's 500 Composite Stock Price Index ("S&P 500 Index"). To pursue this goal, the fund generally is fully invested in stocks included in the S&P 500 Index, and in futures whose performance is tied to the S&P 500 Index. The fund attempts to have a correlation between its performance and that of the index of at least .95, before expenses. A correlation of 1.00 would mean that the fund and the S&P 500 Index were perfectly correlated. The fund generally invests in all 500 stocks in the S&P 500 Index in proportion to their weighting in the S&P 500 Index. The S&P 500 Index is a capitalization-weighted unmanaged index of 500 common stocks chosen to reflect the industries of the U.S. economy and is often considered a proxy for the stock market in general. The fund may also use stock index futures as a substitute for the sale or purchase of securities.

PORTFOLIO MANAGEMENT

The fund's investment adviser is BNY Mellon Investment Adviser, Inc. (BNYIA). BNYIA has engaged its affiliate, Mellon Investments Corporation (MIC), to serve as the fund's index manager. David France, CFA, Todd Frysinger, CFA, Vlasta Sheremeta, CFA, Michael Stoll and Marlene Walker Smith are the fund's primary portfolio managers, positions they have held since October 2020. Messrs. France, Frysinger and Stoll and Ms. Sheremeta are each a senior vice president and senior portfolio manager at MIC. Ms. Walker Smith is a senior director and head of equity index portfolio management at MIC.

The investment objective and policies of the fund may be similar to those of other funds managed or advised by BNY Mellon Investment Adviser, Inc. However, the investment results of the fund may be higher or lower than, and may not be comparable to those of any other BNY Mellon Investment Adviser, Inc. and/or any Sub-Investment Adviser fund.

The fund is only available as a funding vehicle for variable annuity contracts and variable life insurance policies. Individuals may not directly purchase shares of the fund.
