## WHY FIXED INCOME?

Fixed income is more important than it has been for many years. Bonds and credit still help diversify portfolios and reduce volatility, but higher yields now mean they can also make a meaningful contribution to returns.

Actively managed fixed income funds can help investors make the most of higher fixed income yields. Being dynamic across risk factors and the ability to adapt as market change, helps to achieve attractive risk adjusted returns while maintaining fixed income's defensive benefits investors expect.

## WHY INVEST IN THE RESPONSIBLE HORIZONS UK CORPORATE BOND FUND?

The Responsible Horizons UK Corporate Bond Fund provides investors with a core Sterling Investment Grade allocation capable of producing superior excess returns whilst at the same time working towards a 2050 net-zero target. The Fund seeks to enhance risk-adjusted returns by flexibly drawing on multiple sources of performance. This includes opportunistically deviating from benchmark positions and using a global rates overlay to take directional duration bets.

As a core sterling investment grade allocation or as part of a responsible investment portfolio, the Responsible Horizons UK Corporate Bond Fund is designed to enhance stability, resilience and diversification into sterling investment grade allocations and produce a meaningful impact on overall portfolio returns.

## WHAT DOES THE FUND INVEST IN?

The Fund invests primarily in the Sterling Investment Grade Bond universe, as represented by its benchmark the S&P iBoxx GBP Collateralized and Corporate index. As a Fund working towards a 2050 net-zero target, it will not invest in names which do not comply with Insight's ESG exclusions and aims to hold at least 15% of the portfolio in green or other impact bonds.

## HOW DOES THE RESPONSIBLE HORIZONS UK CORPORATE BOND FUND OUTPERFORM THE BENCHMARK?

Credit selection decisions are at the heart of delivering on the Fund's objective of outperforming the benchmark over any rolling three-year period and achieving the embedded 2050 net-zero target. The fund management team invests only in issuers where they hold a strong fundamental conviction, who are already committed—or are rapidly committing—to a credible 2050 net-zero pathway, and whose debt is of sufficient liquidity and attractively valued in the market.

Minimising downside risk and avoiding defaults is essential to generating consistent returns. To support this, Insight's approach focuses on identifying factors that could trigger a sudden or unexpected deterioration in an issuer's ability to repay its debt and analyse whether the spread is adequately compensating for these risks.

## RESPONSIBLE HORIZONS UK CORPORATE BOND FUND

**Objective** To generate a return through a combination of income and capital returns, whilst taking environmental, social and governance ("ESG") factors into account. The Fund targets the outperformance of the S&P iBoxx GBP Collateralized & Corporate Index after fees over any rolling three year period (meaning a period of three years, no matter which day you start on). However, performance is not guaranteed and a capital loss may occur.

**Benchmark** The Fund will measure its performance against the S&P iBoxx GBP Collateralized & Corporate Index (the "Benchmark") after fees over any rolling three year period (meaning a period of three years, no matter which day you start on). The Fund will use S&P iBoxx GBP Collateralized & Corporate Index as a target for the purposes of monitoring the risk taken in the Fund and the UK Investment Association's Sterling Corporate Bond NR Sector average as an appropriate comparator because it includes a broad representation of similar Sterling denominated funds that invest in corporate bonds. The Fund is actively managed, which means the Investment Manager has discretion to invest outside the Benchmarks, subject to the investment objective and policy as disclosed in the Prospectus.

## KEY INVESTMENT RISKS
